(For “D” user)

Scope of disclosure : Open to the public

This guide line shall be applied when ECALS product information content user (Hereafter called "D" user) uses the contents. (The ECALS content is electric data of product catalog made by each content supplier (called "C" user)).

**(2. Purpose)**

To clarify use when ECALS contents that D user obtained were used and the allowed range of use, this guideline was enacted.

**(3. Priority of law)**

Regulations of the relating law are applied about the matter that there are no regulations in this guideline.

**(4. Using conditions)**

Use range

D user should use ECALS contents only for the business improvement of an own company, and D user must not misappropriate ECALS contents without permission with the assumption as business contents etc. (regardless of for a fee or free of charge).

ECALS contents obtained as D user and contents that process it can be offered to the third party only when using it by the purpose of the business improvement of D user.

**(5. Case of data processing)**

It is assumed what D user does under the self-responsibility, and doesn't install the restriction about the method and the content of the processing about the processing of ECALS contents obtained as D user.

**(6. Freshness of EACLS contents)**

D user must agree for new contents for ECALS contents to be updated at any time, to be added or to be added at any time, and serve to always obtain the latest contents when you use ECALS contents.

**(7. Handling of information acquired from management service partner and others)**

Base on handling when contents based from the ECALS operational service partner (P user) and other EC sites to ECALS are obtained to the contract with a member etc. concerned.
